2. MEMBERSHIP

Necessary alternation in the office room to accommodate this very welcome addition have been made during the year. While carrying out these alterations, repairs to the walls and a change of floor tiles were also carried out giving a new look to the Office premises.

10. ACCOUNTS

During the year, the Sabha carried out painting of the Pavilion and also had to incur expenditure on Pavilion Repairs & Maintenance. This, coupled with the expenses on Office Renovation as detailed above resulted in expenditure on Repairs & Renovation amounting to over Rs.2.50 lacs during the year. Continued support from sponsors, donors, advertisers and well-wishers and the various activities enabled the Sabha to absorb this expenditure and post a surplus of Rs.80,928/-. Also, this expenditure had been anticipated in earlier years and a Fund for Sports Pavilion Building and Office Repairs, Renovation And Extension had been built from the surplus of earlier years and the balance in this Fund as on 31.3.1997 was Rs.3,30,000/-. From this Fund, a sum of Rs.70,000/- was utilized during the year bringing the surplus available for appropriation to Rs.150,928/-

From this surplus, Rs.1,20,000/- was appropriated towards Sports Pavilion Building And Office Repairs, Renovation and Extension Fund. Balance surplus of Rs.30,928/- has been added to the brought forward surplus of Rs.1,49,143/- and cumulative surplus of Rs.1,80,071/- is carried forward.

In addition, various specific activity funds of the Sabha made a surplus of Rs.1,05,954/- during the year, which has been transferred to the respective Funds.

Investments of the Sabha as on 31st March 1998 are Rs.22.02.980/-

Since 1995, the G.S.B.S. Sports Committee has been putting efforts to increase sports activities. The efforts are finding good response from sponsors as also participants.

Our special mention and sincere thanks goes to Mr. Dilip Piramal, Chairman of BLOW PLAST LTD., the makers of VIP Luggage who has been supporting the Cricket coaching camps every year. The nearby School boys are taking advantage of these BLOW PLAST COACHING CAMPS. G. S. B. Sabha is indebted to the unfailing support of Blow Plast Ltd. for this activity year after year. REPORT - G.S.B.S MEDICAL TRUST

G.S.B.Sabha started the Medical Services in the year 1967 in the Sabha's office introducing free innoculations for certain preventive diseases on Sunday mornings between 10 a.m. and 12 noon to our

community members. This Service was named as G.S.B.Sabha's Medical Trust in the year 1973- which is an independent charitable organisation with Income Tax exemption under section 80 G of the Income Tax Act, 1961. The Trust has been conducting Medical services in Shilpa Apartment, Dasturwadi ,Dadar from the year 1980, rendering the services to one and all- without any distinction of caste and community.

The following Medical services are available:-

A complete medical check-up scheme with concession to Senior Citizens.

A Diagonostic Centre with about 70 consultants on the Panel, in various specialities

A fully equipped Pathology unit for all tests and up-to-date X-Ray Unit.

A dental unit including Orthodontology and Dental Laboratory, a complete eye examination unit, a Physiotherapy Unit, E.C.G. and Sonography facilities etc.

The Trust also conducts an Under-Five Well-Baby clinic and FREE innoculation for preventive diseases on every Sunday morning between 10 a.m. and 12 noon. It also lends bed-side appliances like Oxygen Cylinder, Cardiac Bed, Wheel Chair, Commode, etc.

The renovation of the Trust premises is almost complete which gives a new look to the centre and better facilities to the patients. I.C.I.C.I Ltd. has recently donated a sum of Rs.25 lakhs for the Colour Doppler Sonography Machine for the Centre.

The facilities are mainly meant for economically weaker sections of people of all communities and therefore, the charges for the services are very nominal. For very poor patients attending the Centre ,there is a special FREE DRUG FUND to help them with free medicines.

The members of the G.S.B.Sabha are given 50% concession in charges for consultations only in Diagnostic Consultation Department.

Donations to the Medical Trust are exemt from Income-Tax under Section 80-G of the Income Tax Act 1961.
