Dr.(Mrs.)Swati Piramal was thanked for making available the spacious lawns and other facilities at this beautiful place. Mr.Manerikar was thanked for making all arrangements to make the day a comfortable one. As in previous years, Shri G.S.Bhat sponsored the programme and added to the liveliness of the day by his enthusiastic participation. This leading businessman of the community has been instrumental in organising several programmes for the Senior Citizens.

4. MARRIAGE INFORMATION SERVICE

G.S.B.Sabha's Mahila Shakha has been providing this service to the community by meeting on 2nd and 4th Tuesdays of every month at Sabha's office. It has been contributing over a decade to this cause by publishing a List Of Eligible Boys along with their details i.e., date of birth, height, gotra, educational qualifications and addresses of parents/guardians. People from all over India, as also people residing abroad, have started sending bio-data's of eligible boys to the Sabha's office to incorporate the names in the Eligible Boys list. As a result both boys and girls get wider

choice to select a suitable life partner. This service is now supplemented by holding Get-togethers of eligible boys and girls along with their parents/ guardians which has been a big success. As people are dispersed all over Greater Mumbai and nearby cities, these meetings provide a platform for interaction for both the parties. Sabha is receiving innumerable letters appreciating this service from boys parties also. The response in terms of alliances materialising as a result of these get togethers is very encouraging. Community people need to be thanked for coming forward enthusiastically to sponsor this activity. This way, G. S. B. Sabha's Mahila Shakha is helping the community to solve one of its big problems by self help. During the year, 4 get togethers of eligible boys and girls along with their parents were held, details about which are given in the Mahila Shakha report printed elsewhere in this report.

5. VIDYANIDHI FUND

G.S.B.Community knows the value of education. G.S.B.Sabha's Vidyanidhi Fund is used to disburse financial assistance to the economically backward and needy students of the community. As there are more needy people and as the cost of living and the educational expenses are escalating Sabha appeals to all members to donate generously to this Vidyanidhi Fund.

During the year, Sabha gave cash assistance of Rs. 69,350/- to 174 School students and Rs. 31,350/- to 57 college students. In addition Sabha selected 5 economically backward students pursuing professional education who were given Rs.1000/- each.

The Sabha is helped in this cause during past several years by Shri Walkeshwar Kashi Math by donating Rs. 6000/- annually. Also Rs. 2,501/- was donated by G. S. B. Sarvajanik Ganeshotsav Samiti, Wadala. In addition our members and well-wishers whole heartedly donate towards this Scheme. In this year, a sum of Rs. 62,078/- was so collected.

6. A Happy Life - Guidelines to Householders and Youth

This booklet contains in simple language the profound teachings of His Holiness Shrimad Sudhindra Thirtha Swamiji of Sree Kashi Math Samsthan to all sections of people. Further to our earlier donation of Rs.20,000/- on publication of the first edition, another contribution of Rs.10,000/- was given towards Swamiji's project of Sree Madhavendra Hospital at Haridwar,

from the sale proceeds of the second edition of the booklet.

This booklet is nominally priced at Rs.10/- The G.S.B.Sabha appeals to all to buy copies and distribute them to their friends and relatives, particularly to the youth. The entire surplus from the sale of this booklet will be donated to the Madhavendra Hospital supported by Swamiji.

7. Bhajans & Religious Programmes:

- a) The Upakarma Homa (changing of the sacred thread) on 'Suta Punav' day was held on 17th August 1999 at the Sabha's office between 7 a.m. and 12 noon for which members were sent advance intimation.
- b) Bhajans are held every Friday evening at the Sabha's Office between 7.00 and 9.00 p.m. Apart from this, Bhajans are held on auspicious days like Kartik Ekadashi, Dassera and the first day of Swamiji's Chaturmas.
- c) The Annual Saptha Bhajan at Shree Walkeshwar Kashi Math, Walkeshwar; Shri Rama Naama Bhajans at Shree Rama Mandir, Wadala and Ekha Bhajans at Shree Balaji Mandir, Kurla are the other religious activities in which the Sabha participates every year.
- d) The Annual Pooja at Sree Walkeshwar Kashi Math was held on 1st Sunday of the Year.

8. MAHILA SHAKHA

The Mahila Shakha conducts several programmes. A detailed report of its activities is printed elsewhere in this Report. The 25th December Anand Bazaar and 26th January Get-together were the major programmes conducted by the Mahila Shakha during the year under review. A sum of Rs. 34,000/- was collected by the Mahila Shakha as General Donations during the year.

G.S.B.Sabha's Mahila Shakha gives Marriage Assistance to the needy. Last year 8 applicants were given Rs.3000/- each. This year the assistance amount has been raised to Rs.4000/- per eligible applicant. Mahila Shakha appeals to all members of the Community to strengthen the Marriage Assistance Fund so that higher amount of assistance can be given.

9. SPORTS PROGRAMMES

Since 1995, the G.S.B.S. Sports Committee has been putting efforts to increase sports activities. The efforts are finding good response from sponsors as also participants.

The emphasis on Sports Activities continued in the year with regular Blow Plast sponsored Cricket Coaching Camps being conducted throughout the year. Also, the 7th District Level Open Carrom Tournament sponsored by Bank Of Baroda was held during the year. The ground and the pavilion are being used by schools/institutions for their various sports events. A detailed report of the Sports Pavilion Sub-Committee is given elsewhere in the Report.

10. ACCOUNTS

The Sabha had a surplus of Rs. 1,76,427/- during the year, thanks to the support from sponsors, donors, advertisers and well-wishers. After transferring utilizations of Rs. 50,000/- made during the year from Income tax allocations made in earlier years, the surplus available for appropriations was Rs. 2,26,427/-. From this surplus, the following appropriations were made:

Sports Pavilion Builiding & Office Repairs,

Renovation And Extension Fund Rs. 1,25,000/-

M.S.Marriage Assistance Endowment Fund Rs. 35,000/-

Bhajan Committee Fund Rs. 40,000/-

Balance surplus of Rs. 26,427/- has been added to the brought forward surplus of Rs. 2,06,487/- and cumulative surplus of Rs. 2,32,914/- is carried forward.

In addition, various specific activity funds of the Sabha made a net surplus of Rs. 80,896/- which has been transferred to the respective funds.

Investments of the Sabha as on 31st March 2000 were Rs. 29,43,917/-.

REPORT - G.S.B.S MEDICAL TRUST

The G.S.B.Sabha's Medical Trust at its Centre reveives over 40,000 out-patients every year, and the centre treats them without any distinction of caste, creed and community. The facilities constitute the departments of Pathology Ultra-sonography, X-Ray, Radiography, ECG, Dental, Audiology, Speech Therapy, Neurology, E.N.T., Ophtholmology,

gynaecology and physiotherapy. Most of these departments are open from 8.00 A.M. to 5.00 P.M. all six days of the week.

In the Pathology department, a fully automated Coulter blood cell counter, capable of providing the analysis within 60 seconds with high level repeatability and reliability was installed coupled to a computer to print out the test results. Several new tests are now being conducted inhouse amounting to better utilisation of the available facilities and consequent cost reduction. In the X-Ray Dept. a new automatic film processor was installed to get films ready for issue within 120 seconds.

Over sixty consultants with wide experience provide services in the areas of Cardiology including 2-D Echo Cardiology, Chest and T.B., Dermatology, Diabetology, Gen-medecine, Haematology, Paediatry, Psychiatry and Surgery.

On Sundays a separate panel of Doctors attend the centre, to deal with the Well-Baby clinic.

The centre endeavours to cater these services at low rates affordable to the poor and under-privileged of the society. An internal orientation and customer inter-face programme have been commenced to achieve better relationship.

The members of the G.S.B.Sabha are given 50% concession in charges for consultations only in Diagnostic Consultation Department.Donations to the Medical Trust are exempt from Income-Tax under Section 80-G of the Income Tax Act 1961.


