4. MAHILA SHAKHA COMMITTEE

4 (A) The Mahila Shakha Committee is the vibrant and dedicated group of women working towards furthering the objectives of the Sabha. A detailed Report of the Mahila Shakha is printed elsewhere in this report. Last year, the Mahila Shakha Committee collected an amount of Rs. 68,450/- by way of donations and advertisements.

The Mahila Shakha Committee manages a Marriage Assistance Fund from which a financial assistances of Rs. 6,000/- per beneficiary is given. In the year 2009-2010, 5 families availed themselves of the benefit of this assistance.

4(B) MARRIAGE INFORMATION SERVICE:

This is one of the most popular activities of the Mahila Shakha Committee. Over the years the popularity of this activity has grown tremendously. On the 2rd and 4th Tuesday of every month, informal meetings are held by the Mahila Shakha at the Sabha's Office between 4.00 p.m. to 6.00 p.m. where the parents of eligible boys/ girls come and exchange horoscopes.

The Mahila Shakha Committee also compiles a list of eligible boys which is released twice a year. The Master list is released in July

and the supplementary list is released in January.

Periodic Get-together of eligible boys and girls are held where the youngsters are given an opportunity to interact with each other.

A detailed report of the Mahila Shakha Committee is given elsewhere in this report.

5. VIDYANIDHI FUND

The Sabha has been giving Educational Assistance to the needy students of our Community under the Vidyanidhi Fund. In the year under review an amount of Rs.1,97,100/- was disbursed, the break-up of which is given below:

1. School Students 174 students : Rs. 1,04,400/-

2. College Students (upto graduate level) 94 students : Rs. 75.200/-

Post-graduates, professionals etc.
 14 students : Rs. 17,500/-

The Managing Committee is grateful to the donors who whole heartedly donate to this fund.

6. DESTITUTE SENIOR CITIZENS WELFARE FUND:

This Fund was launched in 2006 for the welfare of needy senior citizens of our Community. The assistance is given in terms of quarterly financial disbursement of Rs. 900/- to each beneficiary. Medical assistance is also provided in deserving cases. A total of 11 beneficiaries were provided assistance of Rs. 36,900/- from this Fund during the year.

7. MEDICAL AID FUND

This Fund was launched on 5.4.2009, during the Gudi Padva Sneh Milan programme. The Community has responded fantastically to this initiative and more than Rs. 11 lacs has been collected in this Fund. The Managing Committee has framed guidelines for scrutiny of applications and selection of beneficiaries. During the year, three applicants were disbursed a total amount of Rs. 15,000/- from this Fund.

8. BHAJANS / RELIGIOUS PROGRAMMES :

- a) Weekly Bhajans, led by Shri Vijay Ajgaonkar, are held on Friday at the Sabha's Office from 6.00 p.m. onwards. Bhajans are also held on auspicious days like Kartik Ekadashi, Dassera and the first day of Swamiji's Chaturmas.
- b) The Annual Pooja at Shree Walkeshwar Kashi Math was held on 3rd January, 2010.
- c) The Annual changing of the sacred thread was held on 6th August, 2009.
- d) The Sabha also participated in the Annual Saptha Bhajan at Shree Walkeshwar Kashi Math, Shri Rama Naama Bhajans at Shree Rama Mandir, Wadala, Ekka Bhajan at Balaji Mandir, Kurla and Bhajans during Ganeshotsav at Wadala.

9. SPORTS ACTIVITIES

Sports activities are carried out at the Sports Club and its adjoining play ground.

(A) M.R. PAI MEMORIAL CARROM TOURNAMENT FOR PHYSICALLY CHALLENGED

The Bank of Baroda sponsored "M.R. Pai Memorial Carrom Tournament for the Physically Chatlenged" was held on Sunday, 21st February, 2010.

About 100 participants from various institutions such as NASEOH, Fellowship of the Physically Handicapped, Paraplegic Foundation, Bombay Centre for the Deaf, Vocational Rehabilitation Centre etc. participated in the full day event.

The categories were Wheel Chair, Deaf and Mute, Mentally Challenged, Physically Challenged and Ladies Group.

Shri Mohanachandrakaima I.E.S., Assistant General Manager, Chembur branch of Bank of Baroda, was the Chief Guest for the inauguration function. A lamp was lit in memory of Shri M. R. Pai. President, Smt. Sudha Pai, welcomed the audience. The Chief Guest applauded Sabha for their efforts and encouraged the participants to do well in their games.

After the day long tournament, a prize distribution function was held in the evening. Shri Arun Ghorpade, coach for Indian Deaf cricket team, was the Chief Guest for the same.

(B) CRICKET

A group of enthusiastic members play Volley Ball regularly on the Sabha's ground. Schools and Colleges are given the ground for their annual sports at nominal reimbursement of cleaning charges so as to encourage sports activities.

Some observations are as under :

- In the year 2007-2008, major repairs and renovation work had been carried out at Kreeda Mandir. A provision for extra work done by the contractor, based on the estimate given by him, of Rs.1,85,507/- has been made while drawing up the accounts for the current year. The deficit of Rs. 1,22,313/- has to be viewed in that context.
- 2. The newly launched Medical Aid Fund has received very good response from the members. Total donations of Rs.6,70,019/- were received in Medical Aid Endowment Account, wherein the amount would be invested and interest utilized year after year for disbursement of medical aid. In addition, donations of Rs.4,25,369/- were received as general donations (non-corpus) to Medical Aid Fund which could be used for disbursement. The Managing Committee has framed guidelines for selection of beneficiaries. During the year, 3 beneficiaries were disbursed Rs. 5000/- each. The amount of disbursement is decided based on nature of ailment and financial condition of beneficiary. The Managing Committee will be inclined to disburse higher amounts, per beneficiary, in deserving cases.

REPORT OF THE G.S.B.S. MEDICAL TRUST ANNUAL REPORT FOR THE PERIOD OF APRIL 2010 TO MARCH 2011.

In the year 2010-2011 came good in most ways for the Trust. Improved working results further assured Trustees to plan for expansion of activities.

The Board of Trustees comprised Dr. Suhas Prabhu, President, Dr. A.V. Rao, Hon. Secretary, Dr. P.A. Prabhu, Jt. Hon. Secretary (till Nov. 2010), Dr. (Mrs) Maya Kalelkar, Hon. Secretary (from Nov 2010), Mr. Shrikant Prabhu, Treasurer, Mr. D.A. Kamat, and Mrs. Gita R. Pai met six times during the financial year and exercised commendable control over the operations. Mr. Damodar U. Pai, CEO, till November 17, 2010 and Mrs. Nalini Khudanpur, Administrative Officer (from Nove 2010) made their contribution in planning and execution of the Board's decisions.

As per normal retirement schedule the following Trustees had to retire on 30.06.2010:-

- 1) Dr. A.V. Rao.
- 2) Dr. (Mrs) Maya Kaleikar.

The Board of Trustees on getting consent letter of these 2 Trustees have recommended to re-appoint them as Trustees for the next 3 years.

FINANCE:

Despite an otherwise cheerless year economically, the financial situation of the Trust remained reassuring and sound. The gross earnings touched Rs. 1,90,35,023. The Trust's fixed Deposits totaled Rs. 11,719,246/-in various banking and non-banking institutions. There was a modest surplus at the end of the year in March 2011.

SUPERSPECIALITY CENTRE:

The Centre had good run during the year. Equipment downtime was kept to the minimum with most of them covered by annual maintenance contracts. There were 214 Gastroscopies, 34 Colonoscopies, 312 Mammographies, 281 Stress Tests, 830 2 D Echocardiograms, 1,191 ECGs, 952 X-rays, 1,420 Ultrasonographies, 339 Orthopantomographs, 57 Cephalograms, 100 Pulmonary Function Tests, 76 Elecetrocenphalograms, 487 Complete Health Checkups during 2010-2011. The Total footfall during the year at this Centre remained at 14,598.

MEDICAL CENTRE:

There was a steady flow of patients at Dasturwadi Centre. The total patients serviced during the year remained at 51,639 with the consulting fees Rs. 70/- of every patient.

DHARAVI CENTRE:

The Centre had a fair run during the year 2010-2011.

MEDICAL CAMPS:

- A 15% discount was allowed during the Anniversary Week on all medical checkups conducted from 1st January to 7th January 2011.
- On 25th December 2010 a Medical check-up camp was held for the benefit of the members of the GSB Sabha, Matunga where check up of blood pressure, ECG, RandomSugar Level and simple Eye Check up were carried out.
- 3. Dental Camp was held on 09/02/2011 in Dharavi premises.
- 4. In March 2011, special camp of Annual Medical Checkup was done at Free of cost for seven patients involving an expenditure of about Rs. 4,900/-.

HEALTHY BABY CONTEST:

The Contest during 2010-2011 was held on 19th September 2010 during the Ganeshotsay celebrations at Ram Mandir, Wadala.

The Medical Centre functioned during the period without any break with all the medical equipments new and old in good working condition.




