Dear Members,

The 64th Annual Report and the Audited Statement of Accounts is presented hereunder for the financial year 1st April 1998 to 31st March 1999.

1. A HAPPY LIFE, GUIDELINES TO YOUTH & HOUSEHOLDERS

During Chaturmasa, H.H.Shrimad Sudhindra Tirtha Swamiji of Sree Kashimath Samsthan had camped at Kreedamandir. The Dharmopadesha of His Holiness was recorded by our Trustee, Shri M. R. Pai in the booklet, "A Happy Life, Guidelines To Youth And Householders" and was published by the Sabha. The first edition of 5000 copies was sold out within months. The publication was in great demand not only among G. S. B. Sabha members, but also among the general public. For instance, in Mumbai many copies were bought in bulk by people who appreciated the simple teachings of His Holiness and distributed them amongst their friends. A reprint of 5000 copies is also being sold now. A cheque for Rs.20,000 from the sale proceeds of the 1st. edition was donated to Swamiji, towards Sree Madhavendra Hospital, Haridwar for free medicine to poor people of hilly regions. The Managing Committee has decided to donate the entire surplus arising from the sale of the booklet to the Hospital supported by Swamiji.

Inspired by the reading of his booklet, Smt.Sandhya Pai, Executive Editor of the Kannada Magazine 'Taranga', translated the booklet in Kannada and Shri.Satish Pai, Editor of Udayavani, published it.

This booklet is nominally priced at Rs. 10/-. The G.S.B.Sabha appeals to all to buy copies and distribute them to their friends and relatives, particularly to the youth.

It has been contributing over a decade to this cause by publishing a List Of Eligible Boys along with their bio-data i.e. date of birth, height, gotra, educational qualifications and addresses of parents/guardians. Mumbai and upcountry people, as also people residing abroad, have started sending their biodata to the office to incorporate their names in the eligible boys list. As a result both boys and girls get wider choice to select a suitable life partner. This is now supplemented by holding Gettogether of eligible boys and girls along with their parents/guardians which has been a big success. As people are dispersed all over Greater Mumbai and nearby cities, these meetings provide a platform for interaction for both the parties. Sabha is receiving innumerable letters appreciating this service from boys parties also. The response in terms of alliances materialising as a result of these get togethers is very encouraging. Thanks to community people coming forward to sponsor this activity, G. S. B. Sabha's Mahila Shakha is helping the community to solve one of its big problems by self help. During the year, four get togethers of eligible boys and girls along with their parents were held, details about which are given in the Mahila Shakha report printed elsewhere in this report.

6. VIDYANIDHI FUND

G.S.B.Community knows the value of education..G.S.B.Sabha's Vidyanidhi Fund is used to disburse financial assistence to the economically backward and needy students of the community. Thanks to the continuous support from donors, this scheme could reach the disbursement target of Rs.1,00,000/- well ahead of the target date of Year 2000. As there are more needy people and as the cost of living and the

educational expenses are escalating, Sabha appeals to all members to donate generously to the Vidyanidhi Fund.

The Sabha is helped in this cause during past several years by Shri Walkeshwar Kashi Math by donating Rs. 6000/- annually. Also Rs. 1501/- was donated by G. S. B. Sarvajanik Ganeshotsav Samiti, Wadala. In addition our members and well-wishers whole heartedly donate towards this Scheme. In this year, a sum of Rs. 1,17,719/- was so collected. Sabha gave cash assistance of Rs. 67,700/- to 167 School students and Rs. 32,950/- to 49 college students.

As in the previous year Smt. Gita Piramal donated a large number of good clothes to the Sabha, which in turn were distributed to the Vidyanidhi beneficiaries of the Sabha. Thanks to the kind hearted lady, Sabha has supported the needy students.

7. MAHILA SHAKHA

The Mahila Shakha conducts several programmes. A detailed report of its activities is printed elsewhere in this Report. The 25th December Anand Bazaar and 26th January Get-together were the major programmes conducted by the Mahila Shakha during the year under review. A sum of Rs. 40,850/- was collected by the Mahila Shakha during the year as General Donations.

8. SPORTS PROGRAMMES

The emphasis on Sports Activities continued in the year with regular Blow Plast sponsored Cricket Coaching Camps being conducted throughout the year. Also, the 6th District Level Open Carrom Tournament sponsored by HDFC Ltd. was held during the year. 9. BHAJANS/RELIGIOUS PROGRAMMES

- a) The Upakarma Homa [changing of the sacred thread] on 'Suta Punav' was held on 8th August 1998 at the Sabha's office between 7 a.m. and 12 Noon for which members were sent advance intimation.
- b) Bhajans are held every Friday evening at the Sabha's Office between 7.00 and 9.00 p.m. Apart from this, Bhajans are held on auspicious days like Kartik Ekadashi, Dassera and the first day of Swamiji's Chaturmas.

c) The Annual Saptha Bhajan at Shree Walkeshwar Kashi Math, Walkeshwar; Sri Rama Naama Bhajans at Shree Rama Mandir, Wadala and Ekha Bhajans at Shree Balaji Mandir, Kurla are the other religious activities in which the Sabha participates every year.

10. ACCOUNTS

The continued support from sponsors, donors, advertisers and well-wishers and the various activities generated a surplus of Rs.1,71,415/during the year. Expenditure of more than a lac of rupees was incurred on Pavilion Repairs and Maintenance. This expenditure had been anticipated in earlier years and a Fund for Sports Pavilion Building And Office Repairs, Renovation And Extension had been built from the surplus of earlier years and the balance in this Fund as on 31.3.1998 was Rs. 3,80,000/-. From this Fund, a sum of Rs. 80,000/- was utilized during the year bringing the surplus available for appropriation to Rs. 2,51,415/-

From this surplus, Rs. 2,25,000/- was appropriated towards Sports Pavilion Building And Office Repairs, Renovation and Extension Fund. Balance surplus of Rs. 26,415/- has been added to the brought forward surplus of Rs. 1,80,072/- and cumulative surplus of Rs. 2,06,487/- is carried forward.

In addition, various specific activity funds of the Sabha made a surplus of Rs. 1,78,762/- during the year, which has been transferred to the respective Funds.

Investments of the Sabha as on 31st March 1999 are Rs. 25,24,855/-.

REPORT - G.S.B.S MEDICAL TRUST

The G.S.B.Sabha's Medical Trust at its Centre receives over 40,000 out-patients every year, and the Centre treats them without any distinction of caste, creed and community. The facilities constitute the departments of Pathology, Ultra-sonography, X-Ray, Radiography, ECG, Dental, Audiology, Speech Therapy, Neurology, E.N.T., Ophtholmology, gynaecology and physiotherapy. Most of these departments are open from 8.00 A.M. to 5.00 P.M. all six days of the week.

Over sixty consultants with wide experience provide services in the areas of Cardiology including 2-D Echo Cardiology, Chest and T.B., Dermatology, Diabetology, Gen.Medicine, Haematology, Paediatry, Psychiatry and Surgery.

On Sundays, a separate panel of Doctors attend the centre, to deal with the Well-Baby clinic.

The centre endeavours to cater these services at low rates affordable to the poor and under privileged of the society. An internal orientation and customer inter-face programme have been commenced to achieve better relationship.

New facilities added recently are:- State of the art ULTRA SONOGRAPHY MACHINE with Y2K compliance. High speed X-ray film processor, Opthalmology-motorised vision drum with remote control, Haematology Automatic Analyser/Cell Counter (on order). Negotiations have been taken up to computerise all repetetive nature of work to facilitate better record keeping and retreival.

A plaque showing list of donors has now been installed in the hall.


