A detailed Report of the Mahila Shakha is printed elsewhere in this report. Last year, the Mahila Shakha Committee collected an amount of Rs. 23,000/- by way of donations and advertisements.

The Mahila Shakha Committee manages a Marriage Assistance Fund from which financial assistance is disbursed to support the marriage of daughters of our community. During the year, one family availed the benefit of this assistance and Rs. 10,000/- was disbursed to them.

#### 4 (B) MARRIAGE INFORMATION SERVICE:

This is the most popular activities of the Mahila Shakha Committee. Over the years the popularity of this activity has grown tremendously. On the 2<sup>nd</sup> and 4<sup>th</sup> Tuesday of every month informal meetings are held by the Mahila Shakha at the Sabha's Office between 4.00 p.m. and 6.00 p.m. where the parents of eligible boys/girls come and exchange horoscopes. The Mahila Shakha Committee also compiles list of eligible boys which is released twice a year. The Master list is released in July and the supplementary list is released in January. Periodic Get-together of eligible boys and girls is held where the youngsters are given an opportunity to interact with each other. During the year, the 60<sup>th</sup> such get-together was held.

A detailed report of the Mahila Shakha Committee is given elsewhere in this report.

#### 5. VIDYANIDHI FUND

The Sabha has been giving Educational Assistance to the needy students of our Community under the Vidyanidhi Fund. During the year under review, the total amount disbursed was Rs. 3,06,400/the break-up of which is given below:

#### 6. DESTITUTE SENIOR CITIZENS WELFARE FUND

This Fund was launched in 2006 for the welfare of needy senior citizens of our Community. The assistance is given in terms of quarterly financial disbursement, which has disbursed at Rs. 1200/- per quarter to each beneficiary in this year. A total of 22 beneficiaries were provided assistance of Rs. 1,13,800/- from this Fund during the year.

#### 7. MEDICAL AID FUND

This Fund was launched during the Gudi Padva Sneh Milan programme of 2009. The Managing Committee has framed guidelines for scrutiny of applications and selection of beneficiaries. During the year, a total of 17 applicants were granted benefit ranging from Rs. 2,500/- to Rs. 35,000/- to the Fund. Total assistance to these beneficiaries during the year was Rs. 2,16,000/-

#### 8. GSB SENIOR CITIZEN MEDICAL WELFARE FUND

A very generous donation of Rs.50 Lacs by Shri Gurpur Dattanand Bhat, in memory of his late wife Smt. Shanta Bhat, enabled the Sabha to launch this Fund. The fund is one-of-its-kind, dedicated to meet the domiciliary medical expenses of economically weak senior citizens of our Community. Most of these senior citizens are taking some medicines on a daily

basis to mitigate against ailments such as Blood Pressure, asthama, diabetes etc. These medicines which are to be taken on a daily basis are a financial drain for these economically needy senior citizens. On receipt of the application, committee members visit these senior citizens at their homes. In these visits, we help these senior citizens to fill out the form and we collect all necessary supporting documents such as Doctor prescriptions, medicine bills etc. which would support the application. The form is then sent to our panel doctor, Dr. R. N. Kini, who verifies the same from the medical perspective and recommends a monthly limit which can be sanctioned by the Committee to the applicant for the cost of medicines needed by him/her. The beneficiary then submits bills for the medicines purchased by them. The Sabha processes the same and reimburses the cost to the beneficiary, to the extent of sanctioned limit. During the year under review, 11 beneficiaries were disbursed a total amount of Rs. 26,250/- from this Fund.

#### 9. GSB EMPLOYMENT FACILITATION SERVICES (EFS)

The Sabha launched this initiative during the Gudi Padva Programme held on April 14, 2013. With this service, we hope to meet the needs and aspirations of job-seekers in our Community. We act as facilitators serving as a link between the job-seekers and employers. To make this project a success we require the encouragement of potential employers as much as we need the job-seekers to repose faith in our efforts. We believe this service is contemporary and meets the needs of our present times and hope our Community benefits from this service in the years to come.

#### 10. YOUTH WING

On 25th December, 2013, GSB Sabha launched its Youth Wing. The future of every Community is in its youth. In order to instill a spirit of community bonding and service, we have launched this Youth Wing and membership is open to all youngsters (age 18 to 35) of our GSB Community. We intend to conduct activities/hold programs of the Youth Wing which meet the aspirations of the youth.

#### 11. BHAJANS / RELIGIOUS PROGRAMMES:

- a) Weekly Bhajans, led by Shri Vijay Ajgaonkar, are held on Friday at the Sabha's Office from 6.00 p.m. onwards. Bhajans are also held on auspicious days like Kartik Ekadashi, Dassera and the first day of Swamiji's Chaturmas.
- b) The Annual Pooja at Shree Walkeshwar Kashi Math was held on 5th January, 2014.
- The Annual changing of the sacred thread was held on 20<sup>th</sup> August, 2013
- d) The Mahila Shakha Bhajan Group of the Sabha also:
  - participated in Rama Navami Bhajans from Gudi Padva to Rama Navami Day at Sri Rama Mandir, Wadala
  - ii. rendered bhajans on Ashadha Ekadashi (19th July, 2013) at Sri Ram Mandir, Wadala
  - iii. rendered Bhajans at the Ganesh Chaturthi festival at Wadala Math.
  - iv. took part in Saptha bhajans at Walkeshwar.

Some observations on Accounts are as under:

- 1. For the first time in the history of the Sabha, expenditure on Trust objects crossed the figure of 10 lacs. Total expenditure on trust objects was Rs. 13.24 lacs, vis-à-vis Rs. 9.72 lacs spent last year. This amount represents the expenditure on disbursement of educational assistance, assistance to senior citizens, medical aid, marriage assistance, sports expenses and expenses on social functions. This represents 65 % of total expenditure.
- 2. From the surplus, Sabha has allocated Rs. 25 lacs to be spent on Pavilion Repairs and Renovation. The Committee plans to

take up repairs and renovation work at pavilion soon. The option of extending the building will also be explored.

3. In the last Annual Report, we had reported that Investments as on 31.03.2013 stood at Rs. 102.12 lacs and had crossed the landmark figure of Rs. 100 lacs for the first time in the history of the Sabha. We are happy to report that with the support of all donors and well-wishers, the investments figure as on 31.03.2014 stood at Rs. 188.51 lacs.

#### REPORT OF THE GSBS MEDICAL TRUST

GSBS Medical Trust is an offshoot of the Gowd Saraswat Brahman Sabha of Matunga, Mumbai. The Trust was formed as a Charitable one in 1973 for rendering quality healthcare service at economical rates to the needy and the deprived of the City without consideration of caste, creed or religion.

The activities started in 1967 in a limited area set apart by the Dwarkanath Bhavan at Wadala where a few enterprising Doctors commenced their service of the poor with Medical Diagnostic assistance. With crowds increasing day by day it was decided to form a Trust and shift the activities to a new location at Dadar in 1973.

One of its kind in a convenient, well connected location within an earshot of Dadar Central Railway Station, the Trust runs two Centres close to each other. The first Medical Centre has fully equipped Pathology, Digitalised X-ray, including an Image Intensifier TV(IITV), Dental and Physiotherapy Departments. The second, a Superspeciality Centre has facilities in place for Ultrasonography including Colour Doppler for Cardiac and Peripheral Vascular Doppler Tests, Stress Test, 2-D Endoscopy, Mammography, Echocardiogram, Electroencephalography, ECG, Orthopantomography, Cephalography and Pulmonary Function Test. The Consultation Faculty includes General Medicine, Cardiology, General Surgery, Cardiothoracic Surgery, Nephrology and Urosurgery, Neurology. Gastroenterology, Orthopaedics, Paediatrics, Ophthalmology,

The Trust has its 3<sup>rd</sup> centre at Dharavi on Sion-Bandra Link Road and has facilities for Pathology, Dentistry, X-Ray, and Consultation facility in General medicine and Paediatrics.

ENT. Psychiatry ,Gynaecology, and Onco-Surgery.

The 3 Centres together receive over 250 patients daily for various diagnostic investigations. Over the last 40 years of its operations, the Medical Trust must have rendered medical service at

affordable rates to well over a million patients who keep returning to the Centre for any of their physical investigations. This is the measure of the seminal contribution made by the Trust in the service of the local population.
